



Our charity partner, Soldier On, is a not-for-profit veteran organisation delivering a range of services to veterans who have served in the Defence Force since 1990 and their families.

Soldier On was established by John Bale, Cavin Wilson and Dr Danielle Clout in 2012 following the death of John's close friend, Lieutenant Michael Fussell in Afghanistan in 2008. Together, they identified that there was a need for support for veterans and their families injured both physically and psychologically in incident's similar to

In its first year, Soldier On assisted 200 veterans. In 2015, Soldier On assisted 500 veterans a month. Since 1990, over 290,000 men and women have served our country in the Australian Defence Force. But this service to our country can take a toll and some veterans struggle to readjust to a normal life.

Solider On's Veteran and Family Support Program provides veterans and families with mental health support, employment and education support and reintegration support. These vital services help veterans and their families overcome any impacts from their service and build successful futures.
