Comprehensive Credit Reporting (CCR)

There has been an important change to how credit is reported across numerous financial institutions, including Australian Military Bank, called Comprehensive Credit Reporting (CCR). As this may affect how you acquire lending products with us in the future, we want to share with you the key points of CCR.

What's changing?

We will share additional consumer credit account information, such as:

- Your repayment history for credit accounts (whether repayments met the minimum requirement or were made on time);
- The type of credit account opened;
- The date the credit account was opened/closed;
- The name of the credit provider and whether they are a licensed credit provider; and
- The current limit on the credit account.

How this benefits you

You can use your positive credit rating as leverage when looking for a loan. With your details, lenders can better assess you and clarify any blemishes in the past, such as one or two missed payments.


