

Duntroon ACT Auction

Terms & Conditons

1. The auction will be conducted at Duntroon Auction Event at Royal Military College, Duntroon Golf Course, 6 Calculus Lane, Campbell ACT 2612 on 9 November 2018. Bidding will commence at 2pm (AEDT), and end at 3pm (AEDT) on 9 November 2018. The Promoter is Australian Military Bank (ABN 48 087 649 741) of PO Box H151, Australia Square NSW 1215.
2. Bids may only be placed by persons over the age of 18 years who are present at the auction.
3. The participant who makes the highest bid at the end of the Auction for that item will be the successful bidder and will be taken to have entered into a contract to purchase the item for that amount. The Promoter's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
4. The succesful bidder will be notified immediately by public announcement at the event and their name will be published on www.australianmilitarybank.com.au from 12 November 2018 for a minimum of 28 days.
5. Upon notification of the successful bid, the successful bidder must make payment arrangements with the Promoter, and organise collection of their item. Title only passes to the successful bidder, and the item may only be collected, once the Promoter has received payment in full.
6. If any auction item becomes unavailable prior to Auction, the Promoter, in its discretion, reserves the right to substitute that item (or that part of the item) with an item to the equal value and/or specification, subject to any written directions from a regulatory authority.
7. Auction items, or any unused portion of an item, are not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be taken as cash.
8. Participants consent to the Promoter using the entrant's name, suburb, likeness, image and/or voice in the event they are a successful bidder (including photograph, film and/or recording of the same) in any media at any time and without remuneration for the purpose of promoting this promotion (including any outcome), and promoting any products manufactured, distributed and/or supplied by the Promoter.
