

What is PayID?

PayID is an address for near real-time payments. This means, you can make and receive payments using something easy to remember, like your mobile number or email address. Once linked to an account of your choice, simply share your PayID with friends, family and colleagues instead of your BSB and account number.

Why register for PayID?

Whether you need to receive payment from a friend for dinner or send money to a loved one, you can now do so in near real-time with PaylD. This means that payments are instant, without having to wait hours, or in some cases, days, for payments to be received.
